SICAV SDESG is an actively managed open-ended daily dealing UCITS V Luxembourg registered global Emerging Markets fund. Investments are from Sovereign transferable debt securities and other instruments issued by Sovereigns and Quasi-Sovereigns denominated in Hard Currencies, including also investing in financial derivative instruments and related synthetic structures and products focussing on issuers satisfying the relevant ESG performance criteria. While the fund references the benchmark for performance comparison, it can differ from the benchmark's composition and also hold assets which are not part of the benchmark.
